
IMPROVE ANIMAL WELFARE AT FARM LEVEL

Cage-free farming systems for laying hens



More <u>animal welfare friendly</u> <u>farrowing systems</u> and prevent piglet mutilations (<u>tail docking and castration</u>)

3. <u>Reduce lameness in</u> <u>dairy cattle</u>



4. Better protect species not yet covered, such as <u>companion animals</u>, <u>donkeys</u> and <u>rabbits</u>

5. <u>Regular Animal Welfare and</u> <u>Health Visits by veterinarians</u>
